### DEACON'S QUESTION BOX

#### **How Often do you Pray to Receive the Eucharist?**

Thinking back to the recent celebration of the Solemnity of The Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, I put the following question to you; "How often do you pray to receive the Sacrament of the Eucharist?" I know you pray for this more often than you think you do. In fact, each time you pray the 'Our Father', you are praying precisely for this gift.

The fourth petition of the prayer says, "Give us this day our daily bread." At first glance, it would appear that there is an unnecessary repetition in this petition; 'day' and 'daily'. Both versions of this prayer found in Matthew and Luke contain this. Why would Jesus repeat Himself?

When we look to the Greek in which these were originally written, we find the word 'daily' expressed as *epiousios*. The first problem is that these two Gospels are the very oldest Greek documents that contain this word. So there is no ability to cross reference with other documents to determine the exact meaning. Most translators look at the parts of this word and believe it means *daily*. But it was not always so.

St. Jerome, the author of the first definitive Latin translation, approached the word as *epi* meaning above and as *ousia* meaning nature or substance. He then translated this petition as "Give us this day our super-substantial bread." I might add that Saint Cyril and Saint Cyprian also translated it in this manner.

This bread is super-substantial because Jesus was referring to His own body and blood. This petition points to the Last Supper and to the offering of His Body and Blood for our salvation. Any ancient Jew who heard these words would immediately think of the manna of the Exodus. In John 6, Jesus refers to Himself as the new manna from Heaven. In the Last Supper, He changes the bread and wine into this new manna, His Body and Blood.

Every time you pray the Rosary, attend Mass, or recite the Our Father, you are praying for the gift of the Eucharist.
