### DEACON'S QUESTION BOX

***We Believe – I Believe – What is the difference?***

Doesn't 'we believe' imply 'I believe'? And when we all say together 'I believe', isn't it the same as 'we believe'? I suppose if we don't look past the grammar of the two, they could be used interchangeably when we are reciting together. That is, when we are reciting anything other than the Creed.

Consider exactly what the Creed is and how it relates to the rest of liturgy. The Creed is the formula of belief we accept at Baptism and is intimately associated with it. Baptism is the Sacrament where we declare our belief and are received into the Church. This reception is not a group reception but an individual one. Even when we celebrate baptism for a group of infants or for a group of adults at Easter Vigil, each of these people individually receives Baptism. From time immemorial, prior to receiving Baptism, the individual, or the parents of the infant, profess these beliefs before the assembled faithful. Eventually, this was added to the Sunday Mass.

The Sacrament of Baptism takes a particular prominence at the Easter Vigil. That night, catechumens follow the ancient practice as I described above and the faithful renew their own baptismal promises. The promises are renewed through a question and answer form. The priest asks a collective question and the answer is always 'I believe'.

The ramifications of "I believe" extend even beyond sacramental connections, and into the actual impact on us. "It is worth speculating what effect this might have on the faithful. It may well be that Mass-goers, suddenly saying 'I believe in one God,' will be jolted into a realization that they are making a personal profession of faith, rather than going along (often unreflectively) with the congregation."<sup>1</sup>
