## **Do we have to believe Mary really appeared at Fatima, Lourdes, and other sites? (Part 2)**

Last month, I discussed whether there existed an obligation to believe Mary appeared at any of the many sites around the world where apparitions have been reported. This month, I want to talk specifically about what was reported at what are probably the two most famous; Fatima and Lourdes.

At Fatima, on October 13, 1917, seventy thousand people witnessed the miracle of the sun dancing and the remarkable drying up of the ground and of the witnesses rain-soaked clothes. It had been raining very hard through the night and into the morning. Not one person has stepped forward in the almost 100 years since to say it was a hoax. It is known that atheists and anti-church witnesses were present and they have remained silent.

Some who were not there have claimed it was a mass hallucination. Hallucination is a solitary phenomenon. There are no medical records of even two people having exactly the same hallucination at the exact same time. So Fatima cannot be reasoned away. One either accepts it as it is or maintains an agnostic position.

Lourdes is a little different. Our Lady of Lourdes is the name used to refer to the Marian apparitions granted to Saint Bernadette Soubirous in 1858. A total of eighteen apparitions were experienced by Bernadette over that year. On the 25<sup>th</sup> of February, Mary asked Bernadette to dig in the ground and drink the water of the spring she found there. This revealed the stream that soon became a focal point of pilgrimages.

Since then, the water of this spring has been credited with many healings. The Church has officially recognized sixty-five of them as miraculous. The declaration of a miraculous cure comes after a very stringent and careful examination by medical experts. It sometimes takes years to make this declaration due to the investigations required.

As I said last month, belief in either of these apparitions is not essential to the faith. Apparitions approved by the Church may, however, be a source of spiritual growth and lead to a stronger faith.
