Pro-life Report: Two events where held over last weekend, Oct 7th & 8th.

The first was a Diocesan Walk for Mary in Peoria form St. Joseph Church downtown to the Cathedral. Adoration and confession, with speakers at St. Joe's started at noon. The walk was held at 2:30 PM starting in the rain and ending at the Cathedral where a Mass was celebrated with Bishop Jenky. Procession of the St. Mary Statue around the Cathedral at the conclusion of Mass. Spalding Assembly 4th Degree Honor Guard was present. Estimated attendance; over 1,000 Pro-Life Catholics. Truly a great event. Bishop rode in a covered golf cart, the rest of us in rain gear & umbrellas..plus two buses for those who could walk.

The second event was a Marion Walk from Sacred Heart Church, RI to St. Mary's Church RI celebrating the 150th anniversary of St. Mary's Church, the oldest Catholic Church in the QC's and the 100th anniversary of the Miracle at Fatima with the procession with St. Mary Statue and the Exposed Eucharist carried by Father Co. Father Bader Assembly provided the Honor Guard with (7) Sir Knights & the Fathers of St. Joseph also participating. Estimated attendance was two hundred to three hundred QC Catholics...

The 2nd report was for the Peoria Chapter Meeting held Sat. Oct. 7th AM in Bloomington, IL:
