

Given the conversations happening in the Public Square today, I want to thank the person who had the courage to send this question to the question box. Let's start by defining the term white supremacy. 'White Supremacy' is the belief that the white race is inherently superior to other races & that white people should have control over people of other races. From the time of the apostles it has been the unchanging teaching of the church that all people regardless of the color of their skin or the consequences of their birth have an equal dignity in the eyes of God & should also have an equal dignity before all of us. In fact, the Catechism says, "every form of social or cultural discrimination in fundamental personal rights must be curbed & eradicated as incompatible with God's design. God the Son did not go to the cross for just a few people but for all humanity. Which prompted St. Paul to say "He indeed died for all so that those who live might no longer live for themselves but for Him who for their sake died & was raised. Consequently, from now on we regard no one according to the flesh." (Second Corinthians 5:15-16)

Regarding the question of sin, we know that sin is an offense against rea-son, truth, & right conscience & is a failure in genuine love. We know we have a responsibility to form our conscience such that it conforms to the teaching of the church. Once formed a right conscience should then direct our thoughts words & actions. Occasionally we all have ideas & thoughts that do not conform to the principles of our faith. It is then our responsibility to measure these thoughts against those principles & discard those that are incorrect. If we obstinately persist in holding onto ideas like white supremacy that would indeed be sinful.
