If you sign up early for the dinner you get 2 dollars off. The dinner receipts and bar sales will be split. Prices are going up. The Italian society asked if the raffle basket and wine pull proceeds can go to the Italian Society for their scholarships fund that they are donating to it. Dick proposed for the Knights to keep the money from it due to the Knights manning it all. Chuck suggests that we give the proceeds from those to the Italian Society since we do not have a set project that it would go to. Kevin Houser suggests that since the Italian Society puts on the dinner and does all

9) New Business:

Abstracts/ Newsletter- Review committee work and proposal- Proposal is for cost reduction. The newsletter cost 34 percent more than last year. 3500 dollars for printed envelopes and postage. That is over 55 percent of the dues if we take all the dues in. Two things the committee did was getting ahold of the members that get both the email copy and hard copy. They also contacted ones that had emails and filtered out the people that are no longer in the system or no longer members. Former members as well it was suggested that they will not get a copy anymore. We are down to about 50 members that will still receive a hard copy. Dick printed out a newsletter using a program called Publisher to cut down on the newsletter to save costs. Got it down to about 4 sheets double sided to send out. Costs will be only 700 a year compared to 3500 dollars a year. Maybe a few Knights can print these copies out in color. 4th degree has used Allouez council newsletter before. Dave Y proposed that maybe the 4th degree council can put some money in to get some of their messages in. We need one person that can raise revenue for the newsletter. Maybe help to get more advertising dollars. Sanctuary marble floor cleaning- Need 3-4 people to help clean the floors maybe April 1st or Good Friday. Use mops and sponges. Professionally it will cost 2000 dollars.
