- 5) Financial Secretary: Balance sheet displayed on the large screen. New item on the balance sheet for undeposited funds. 7) Program Reports:

Faith- Jim W.- Adoration is going well. Holy hour in May. Jim said his Wife was willing to cook after Holy hour. Looking to see if anyone wants to go to Nick Conner ordination ceremony on May 20th to become a Deacon.

Family- Dave Y.- Handed out all the awards to the kids for the free throw contest. Went very well. 4 out of the 12 went to state in the free throw contest. 2 out of the 4, all 4 from Jordan, came in second place and are alternates if someone drops out.

Community-

Blood Drive- April 10th- Louie- 96 people donated for the blood drive. A few people who could not make it can still go to the blood center to count for the blood drive until the end of next week. Louie wants to send it to the national magazine. One council bragged about having 30 people come to theirs.

Italian Dinner- April 22nd- Louie- Louie gave advance money for the Italian dinner to Dick. Louie needs 8 people to serve the meals and get drinks for people. Don't have to give change or mess with money. All tickets for the Italian dinner are now 20 dollars. It is advertised in the church bulletin and on Facebook. Should have a good turnout.

Life- Jack was not present- Dave Yordy- Would like us to get the banner out for pro-life and go over the overpass. Leo council has done it recently and got a lot of reactions good and bad. There are also petitions online to sign wich only takes a few minutes. Everything you do makes a difference.

8) Old Business:

* Abstracts/ Newsletter- Finalize committee work and proposal. Not very many members here at the meeting today so

keeping it brief. Trying to get everyone that has an email the online version of the Abstract to as many members as possible to save money. 4th degree members we need to keep sending the info to as well as the 3 digit raffle players. Instead of sending out 220 copies from Steckers graphics we will be sending out 55 copies. Drops it down to 35 in postage and altogether around 40 or 50 dollars total cost versus 288 a month sending out the old way. The vast majority of Knights have an email now and Dick has them in a central database now. Knights we have email addresses for we will send out the online version.

* Holy Thursday Eucharist Adoration- St. Pius and Sacred Heart- April 6th had 9 people at Sacred Heart and 8 here at St.Pius. So it went pretty well. Would like to have more Knights next year. Had general participation as well. Good comments for the people that were in and out and appreciated that the Knights were there. The swords also add to the presence of the Knights participation. It was noticed that Father Baker was the only Priest that showed up at both Churches. Thinking maybe we should promote it a little more.

9) New Business:

- * Jordan School Annual Fundraiser donation request (We donated 2500 last year) Jordan will hold the fundraiser at the Stern Center this year and that is not going to cost Jordan much this year. Motion to approve donating 2500 again this year was made by Dick Hunt and Seconded by Louie Alongi. Motion was approved.
- * Centralized Database with mailing and email addresses. Dick separated whether people on the list was from Allouez council or affiliated with us in any way. 258 active members. 208 we have email addresses for. Every so often Dick will update the central base. Kevin Barton will update Dick as well from any non members requesting a copy of the Abstract. There is a lookup function in the database that we can find out info on all the members. Parish affiliation is also included on the member info.
- * Seminarian support checks- We are still supporting the 5 seminarians.
- * Columbian Award- Form 10784 for programs, events and activities- Questions? To get the Columbia award we need to submit to the supreme council events like the fish fry, and pro-life dinner and such. The Grand Knight sends in info on how many people were involved in what event. Dave said that the form is really easy to fill out and send in. If not sure what the numbers were, give an estimated number. It is all electronic. Step by step to get to the Comlumbian award form. We have 21 events that we have done as a council. Since last July to June. We can turn these in.
- * Birdies for Charities- Who will take over for Dean Lackey? Rick Cervantes will take over for Dean Lackey. Dick Hunt will send out an email with a link for anyone that wants to donate to it online or who wants to print a form out and send back with a donation. Dick will also be mailing forms out. In the next few weeks.
- * Avenue of Flags- 1st installation in 2023 is Memorial Day- We need more volunteers. May 26th is the put the flags up day. That is the Friday before Memorial Day and we take them down the following Tuesday.

Dick is very appreciative of all the Honor Guard participation. - Dave will not be here this year to take care of the 17th hole at the John Deere Classic. The Thursday and Friday in the tournament are the days to volunteer to represent the Allouez Council. If Dave doesn't get a positive response he will get with the John Deere Classic people to withdraw from the tournament. Chuck Gibbs said he will take the lead on this.
